

HHS EARLY COLLEGE OPPORTUNITIES

1. **Bridge Program**- see description in our Program of Studies. Approximately \$45/credit.

2. **Academ-e** COST TO STUDENT: Books and supplies only. Early college distance program taken online. Academ-e consists of courses representing five broad areas: mathematics, sciences, arts, humanities and social sciences. Courses are offered in an asynchronous online environment and consequently are not dictated by pre-set University or high school schedules. Students must have access to the internet and attend a one-day orientation at the University of Maine. Sign-ups are first come first serve. For more information visit <http://umaine.edu/academ-e/>

3. **Aspirations**-UMAINE SYSTEM COST TO STUDENT: Books, supplies, and must provide own transportation. In-person classes at local colleges or online.

4. **RURAL U** through the University of Maine Fort Kent. COST TO STUDENT: \$85 for live in person HHS classes and \$137.50 for online classes plus cost of books. For more information visit.

5. HERMON HIGH SCHOOL: Offering of classes at HHS through teachers vetted through University of Maine system. Students will receive 1 high school credit per course and 3 college credits. Please refer to Program of Studies for descriptions of classes.

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6. **Husson University**

Husson offers the Early College Access Program (ECAP) for high school students, allowing access to a broad array of classes at a substantial savings from standard tuition rates. Class is free students will pay for books.. Students may enroll in up to two (2) courses per semester as long as published prerequisite requirements have been met and space is available. Courses are available on site in Bangor, Westbrook and Presque Isle, or online statewide.
